Notes:

- **Kyle Palmieri** co-leads the AHL in goals, despite playing 20 fewer games than co-leader Cory Conacher (Norfolk, 25 goals)...ranks second in the league in GWG (6) and ranks tied for ninth in plus/minus (+15)...leads the Crunch in goals and plus/minus, and ranks second with 25-13=38 points in 27 contests...currently has a five-game point streak (6-3=9)...has 13-7=20 points in his last 12 games...appeared in his second AHL All-Star Game (the first player to represent the Syracuse Crunch at two All-Star Games) on Jan. 30, scoring one goal for the Eastern Conference All-Stars.

- **Patrick Maroon** ranks tied for fourth in the AHL in goals and is seventh among league leaders with 22-26=48 points in 44 games...also ranks tied for sixth in the league in PPG (9)...leads the Crunch in points, assists and PPG, and ranks second in plus/minus (+11)...had a four-game point streak (4-2=6) from Jan. 15-22, including a hat trick vs. Norfolk on Jan. 20 (3-1=4)...has 6-4=10 points in his last nine games and 14-15=29 points over the last 26 contests.

- **Peter Holland** ranks third on the Crunch in goals and scoring (16-18=34) in 41 games...also ranks second on the team with seven PPG...has 12-16=26 points in his last 29 contests...ranks tied for fifth among AHL rookies in goals and eighth in scoring.

- **Mathieu Carle** ranks tied for ninth among AHL defensemen in scoring and is tied for sixth in assists with 3-23=26 points in 42 games...ranks second on the Crunch in assists and leads team defensemen in assists and scoring, and ranks second in goals.

- **Bryan Rodney** ranks first in goals and second in scoring among Crunch defensemen with 4-15=19 points in 39 games.

- **Luca Caputi** has scored 5-8=13 points in 14 games with a +5 rating, and has points in 10-of-14 contests since joining the Crunch from Toronto on Jan. 3...had a five-game point streak (2-5=7) from Jan. 6-15.

- **Iiro Tarkki** ranks eighth in the AHL in saves (794)...recorded his second career AHL shutout, stopping all 31 shots faced in a 4-0 win, Jan. 27 vs. Rochester.

- **Justin Schultz** ranks tied for fifth among all NCAA D-1 players in assists and tied for seventh in scoring with 12-26=38 points in 28 games...leads all NCAA D-1 defensemen in goals, assists and points, and is the only defenseman ranked in the top 30 among all NCAA scorers this season...leads Wisconsin in goals, and ranks tied for second in assists, scoring and PPG (5)...he now has 107 career points, becoming the first Badger defenseman to collect at least 100 since Brian Rafalski did so in 1994-95.
- **Brett Perlini** ranks tied for second on Michigan State in scoring and assists with 7-17=24 points in 30 games.
- **Chris Wagner** ranks tied for fifth among all NCAA D-1 players in assists...ranks first on Colgate in assists and second with 10-26=36 points in 27 games...ranks second in ECAC scoring and assists with 8-16=24 points in 16 contests in conference play.

- **Emerson Etem** leads the Canadian Hockey League (WHL, OHL, QMJHL) in goals (49), SHG (10) and GWG (9)... leads the WHL in SHG and GWG...ranks tied for second in the WHL with 49-37=86 points in 48 games (1.79 points-per-game) and is tied for fourth among league leaders in PPG (14)...had a career-high 11-game goal-scoring streak (16-2=18) from Dec. 10-Jan. 27, the WHL's longest goal-scoring streak since the 2003-04 season (Swift Current's Jeremy Williams had a 13-game goal-scoring streak from Nov. 5-Dec. 3, 2003)...currently has a 16-game point streak (21-7=8), the WHL's longest current point streak...had the WHL's second-longest point streak of the season, a career-high 17-game point streak (23-16=39) from Sept. 28-Nov. 5...had an eight-game goal-scoring streak twice, from Oct.18-Nov. 5 (10-8=18) and Sept. 28-Oct. 12 (13-4=17)...has recorded 21 multi-point and nine multi-goal games...leads Medicine Hat in goals, assists, points, plus/minus (+19), shorthanded goals and power play goals (14).
- **John Gibson** ranks second in the OHL in SV% (.932), sixth in GAA (2.60) and tied for 10th in wins (17)...has won 14 of his last 17 starts...leads Kitchener in all major statistical categories for goaltenders.
- **Igor Bobkov** leads the OHL in saves (1,427), and ranks second in minutes (2,585) and games played (45)...leads Kingston in all major statistical categories for goaltenders.
- **Andy Welinski** leads all USHL defensemen in goals and shots (116), and ranks tied for second in the league among blueliners with 12-13=25 points in 35 games...also ranks first among all USHL players in plus/minus (+28).
